

PRESENT SIMPLE – PRESENT CONTINUOUS

A. PRESENT SIMPLE

1. Mary **usually walks** to work. (*walk - usually*)
2. you up early? (*get - in the morning*)
3. They fruit (*eat - every day*)
4. He me. (*believe - never*)
5. The Browns to the cinema on Saturdays. (*go - often*)
6. John a newspaper (*buy - every day*)
7. you your homework carefully? (*do - always*)
8. The City Museum at 5 o'clock (*close - every day*)

B. PRESENT PROGRESSIVE

1. John **is reading** a comic **at the moment** (*read - at the moment*)
2. Paul? (*work - now*)
3. The twins (*sleep - at the moment*)
4. Susan out with Mark (*go - tonight*)
5. The children the exam (*take - next week*)
6. My parents back (*come - tonight*)
7. Mary her teeth ? (*brush - now*)
8. He on the phone (*talk - right now*)

C. PRESENT SIMPLE OR PROGRESSIVE?

1. **Does** he always **work** (*work*) at the weekends?
2. Dad (*drive*) to London tomorrow.
