

# BE GOING TO

## USE - ΧΡΗΣΗ

Σε πολλές περιπτώσεις, αντί για Μέλλοντα χρησιμοποιούμε τη φράση **be going to** (πρόκειται να). Αυτό συνήθως γίνεται:



- α. για να εκφράσουμε  
**ΣΚΟΠΟ - ΠΡΟΘΕΣΗ**,  
• *We are going to sell our house.*



- β. όταν έχουμε ενδείξεις ότι θα γίνει κάτι πολύ σύντομα.  
• *He is going to fall.*

AFFIRMATIVE		NEGATIVE	
I'm	going to pay	I'm	not going to pay
You're	going to pay	You're	not going to pay
He's	going to pay	He's	not going to pay
She's	going to pay		etc.
It's	going to pay	INTERROGATIVE	
We're	going to pay	Am	I going to pay?
You're	going to pay	Are	you going to pay?
They're	going to pay	Is	he going to pay?
			etc.

## ΠΑΡΑΤΗΡΗΣΕΙΣ

- Όπως παρατηρείς, μετά τη φράση **be going to** βάζουμε πάντα **απαρέμφατο**.  
• *He's going to move house.*
- Με τα ρήματα **come** και **go** δεν συνηθίζεται να χρησιμοποιούμε το **be going to** και συνήθως προτιμάμε τον Ενεστώτα Διαρκείας με σημασία Μέλλοντα.  
• *He's going out.* • *She's coming with us.*



– *Can I speak to a doctor, please?*  
*My wife is going to have a baby.*  
– *Is this her first baby?*  
– *No, you idiot. This is her husband!*
